Baby bags, Cartier bracelets and beaded gowns are treasured by this collector, but her close-knit family wins first place

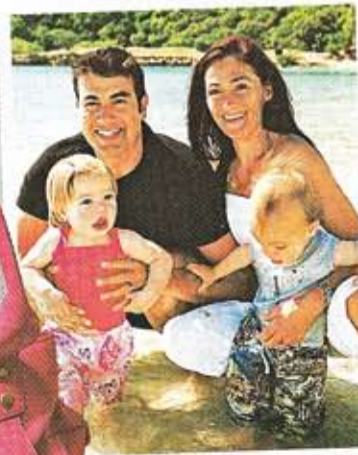
